National Photography Month

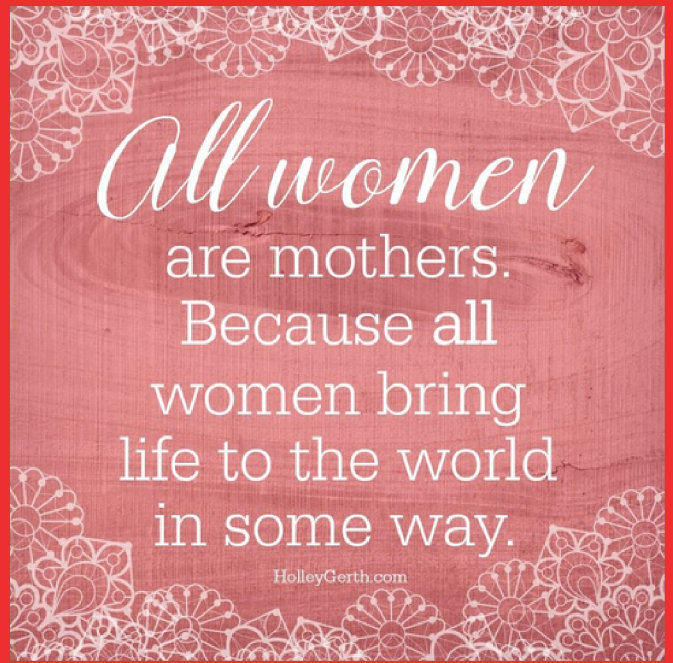
