## Good Luck Charms

A good luck charm is usually an object that people wear or carry with them in hopes of bringing good fortune upon themselves. Common good luck charms are a rabbits foot or a lucky penny. A common lucky charm that we see here at Shore View is a mini Buddha statue. Many folks place them on their bingo cards to help them win!

Different cultures have their own items or symbols they consider lucky. For the Irish you'll see a four leaf clover or shamrock. An elephant, with the nose turned up, is a sign of good luck for many cultures including Thai and Indian. The Maneki-Neko, or waving cat, is a Japanese symbol of luck and good fortune.

Items that may not have cultural associations can also be good luck if the owner feels it to be. A wedding ring that's been passed down through the years can be seen as a symbol of good fortune and longevity in marriage. Some sports fans believe wearing a lucky jersey can help their team win a big game. If you like to hit the casino you may even have a pair of "Lucky Socks" that you always wear! -Chelsea W
